Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

It is not hard to admit that we all have done things that we know is wrong, but yet we do them anyway. That is called sin! We all are guilty of it we have been doing it since we were born.

Joan 3:19 Bisar igade sikepe idung; Angune tani amoso píto, idokom tani kídíe angun empemílo kaamuem míiyato kapeila buluke inam saanamde atímgang.

Rom 3:23 Kapeila takam tanie paab ito delokke Shédíke angun ralnamlo pííramkai,



We are all sinners!

2. By that nature we are condemned.

Joan 6:40 Kapeila ngokke Yayike míínamde Uem kaana delokke bím arope míngkesuna mipíde turyar namem paadope, delokke ngo bím yéyin longelo gakrepyéku.”

Joan 3:18 Séko arope míngke suyédí bím bisarmang, idakkom séko arope míngke sumadí bím bisar tubong kapeila bí Shédíke Oo atel amínem arope míímato.

Joan 3:36 Séko Uem arope míngke sududí bí turyar namem paadung, idola séko Uem tomadudí bí turnamem paamayé, kapeila Shédíke aklíngé bíkkíng duuyé.



There is a cost for sin!

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

Joan 14:6 Jisu bí pobito, “Ngomino bedange, arue delokke turname. Séko kelokte Abu kelo aalamang, ngokke petom lokmin aaladune.

Joan 3:17 Legade Shédí bí tani amongem bisar dope emla bíkke Oo atelem melíkmang idola Bíkkelok mosingkupe emlamin melíktone.

Joan 1:10, 12 Agomde tani amoso yéto, delokke bíkkelok tani amongem pílate tani amonge bím kangkénmato. Depe idokom bím toríksula, bíkke amínlok míngkesuna takamem, bí Shédíke ome-oope ilanana ralnamem bito.

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God’s word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Salvation is trusting and receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior. It's trusting in the fact that Jesus Christ died on the cross of Calvary to pay for your sins! It's realizing there is absolutely nothing whatsoever you can do to save yourself and *completely* trusting in Jesus Christ to save you! It's not any church that saves. It's not any baptism, not good works, not sacraments, not repenting, not praying through, not living a good life — **IT'S NOT ANYTHING YOU CAN DO!**

5. You must believe on the Lord and you will have everlasting life!



Joan 6:47 Ngo nolum aruem podung, séko arope míngke sududí bí duuyarna turnamem paadung.

Joan 10:28 Ngo bulum turyarnam yénamem bidung, delokke bulu edílokom nyokyi mayé; sékote bulum ngokke alaglok rotbín lamayé.



If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you. God said if you receive and trust in Jesus Christ you are saved. Notice it does NOT say you "might" or "could" be saved — but "shall be saved". **YOU ARE SAVED!**
