Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

It is not hard to admit that we all have done things that we know is wrong, but yet we do them anyway. That is called sin! We all are guilty of it we have been doing it since we were born.

We are all sinners!

2. By that nature we are condemned.

Njoana 6:40 I kwenda kwa ûra aantûmire atî, muntû wonthe ûra akoonana na Mwana na amwîtîgie oone mwoyo wa tene na tene, na naani nkamûriûkia ntugû ya mûthia."

Njoana 3:18 Ûra amwîtîgagia atirî na îgamba, îndî ûra atamwîtîgagia wana n'ûmûgiitîre îgamba mwanka agu tûrî îîndî, n'ûntû atiîtîgîîtie riîtwaani rîa Mwana wa Ngai wa kîmoomwe.

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

Njoanana 14:6 Yiesû auga, "I niû njîra, ûmma na mwoyo. Gûtirî we athiyaga kîrî Baaba atakûrûkîîrîte kîrî niû.

Njoana 3:17 Ngai ataatûma Mwana wake nthîgûrû aaya kûgiitîra antû îgamba, îndî naaboonokia.

Njoana 1:10, 12 Kiugo naarî nthîgûrû îno, na nthîgûrû yaûmbirwe gûkûrûkîîra kîrî we, îndî nthîgûrû îtaamûmenya we aarî ûû. Îndî bara bo baamûkeneere bamwîtîgia, naatûmire batuîka aana ba Ngai.

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God's word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Salvation is trusting and receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior. It's trusting in the fact that Jesus Christ died on the cross of Calvary to pay for your sins! Tito 3:5 naatwonokiirie. Ataatwonokia n'ûntû bwa ûntû bwega bûra twarorûtha. I kîao aatwîgiirue atwonokia na njîra ya kûthambua îciarwa rîa maîrî, atûgarûra na njîra ya Kîrundu Ûmûtheru.

5. You must believe on the Lord and you will have everlasting life!

Njoana 5:24 "Na mma ga nkûbwîra, muntû ûra eegagua ntheto ciakwa na ageetîgia ûra aantûmire, ûyu we arî na mwoyo wa tene na tene. We gûtirî îgamba rîra arî na rîo. Narîîkîîtie kuuma gîkuûni aathûngîra mwoyooni.

Njoana 6:47 Na mma ga nkûbwîra, muntû ûra eetîgagia akoona mwoyo wa tene na tene.

Njoana 10:28 Mpeyaga ng'ondu ciakwa mwoyo wa tene na tene. Kwoogu, cio itikooro ikua. Gûtirî we antunya cio kuuma njaraani ciakwa.



If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you.
